Morgan County REA is partnering with our power provider, Tri-State Generation and Transmission, in offering a voluntary Green Power Purchase Program to MCREA members. The renewable energy for the Green Power Program comes from a number of different sources. The green power is purchased on the open market through a system of green tags that derive from energy produced by wind, solar, small hydroelectric and biomass projects. This gives MCREA members the opportunity to promote renewable energy without the expense of installing potentially expensive equipment at their homes or businesses.

MCREA charges only 40 cents per 100 kilowatt-hour block per month of green power. This voluntary program will continue for those who wish to purchase power generated from renewable sources. By signing up for the program at MCREA headquarters, homeowners and businesses can buy green power at an additional, minimal monthly fee, and support the continued development of renewable energy resources.
