

Whole House Surge Protection

Whole House Surge Protection is designed to intercept an electrical spike before damage is caused to anything using electricity inside the home or business. Having surge protection could save the consumer significant inconvenience and money.

The customer receives two lines of defense:

Primary protective device at service entrance

Kit of five (5) plug-in surge suppression devices (a \$100 value)
(Two of these must be installed on incoming telephone & TV lines)



Why Have It?

- Surges can travel on any wire coming into your home. They can even originate within the home as appliance motors turn on and off. Surges can damage an electrical product without your ever knowing it; they may simply shorten the life of your microwave oven, computer, TV, or VCR.
- Lightning may be the prime reason to consider a whole house surge protection program, but having continuous protection year round for your valuable appliances and electronics just makes good sense.

Other Important Information

- Service entrance device is accompanied by a warranty on standard appliances if the service entrance device fails in conjunction with equipment failure.
- Plug-in devices have varying insurance amounts on protected items, such as computers and TV's if they are surge damaged.
- Lightning-related damage is covered.
- Surge suppression devices are replaced by the co-op or the manufacturer.
